The 12th annual Joseph Browne Spring School of Traditional Music takes place in Kinvara!!

The Joseph Browne Spring School of Traditional Music, a regular feature of the Kinvara Music Calendar and now in its 12th year, will take place again this year in St. Joseph's National School from Thursday 15th February to Sat 17th February 2018. Music classes will take place from 10am to 1pm each morning and 'Bearers of the Tradition' workshops, where students are given the opportunity to interact with and learn from members of the traditional music community, will take place on Thurs and Fri afternoons from 1.30pm to 2.30pm This year a 'Peer Performance' Recital will take place on Thurs 1.30 - 2pm This will provide a platform for young musicians to showcase their talents. Let us know if you would like to play a tune or two. Renowned author and musician, Kate Thompson,

will visit the Joseph Browne Spring School also on Thursday when she will give a workshop on care and maintenance of your instrument from 2pm to 2 30pm. On Friday the intricacies of arranging Irish traditional music will be the focus of the afternoon session when Eileen O'Brien will lead a masterclass in arrangement.

The Joseph Browne Spring School provides an excellent opportunity for any children who are already playing an instrument as it allows them to experience music in context while they spend three continuous days playing and learning music with some of the best teachers and performers of traditional music in Ireland. It also provides a place to meet other young musicians from all over Ireland.

Classes are offered in fiddle, tin whistle, accordion, concertina, flute, pipes, guitar, harp, keyboard and uilleann pipes. Banjo classes will be offered depending on demand. The Joseph Browne Memorial Concert is a benefit concert to help towards the cost of running the Spring School and it will be held on Fri night 16th February in KAM's stunning 'Gig Room' in Kinvara Community Centre where many of the tutors will perform. The Rock and Road has announced a new early season marathon in addition to the existing 10k and half marathon races taking place, as always, on the first weekend in **March**, **Saturday 3rd**. The marathon begins and ends on the same route as the scenic half marathon course, but extends further into the Burren landscape taking in the Kilmacduagh Monastery. This event is now in its 8th year and attracts 2000 runners from all over Ireland in no small part due to the huge welcome afforded to the competitors by the local community during the races themselves, at the pier for the finish and on into the evening in the village. This is a great early season goal or test run, particularly for another of the big races in the West - the Connemarathon in April.
